



THE TOGETHER Rx ACCESS™ CARD AT A GLANCE

- The Together Rx Access™ Card is unique because it can allow approximately 36 million uninsured patients – 80 percent of the total uninsured population – to access a broad range of prescription medicines and products at a savings through a free, easy-to-use card. In addition, the Together Rx Access Program directs individuals to the Partnership for Prescription Assistance (PPA), a clearinghouse for over 475 public and private assistance programs, including participating companies' existing Patient Assistance Programs.
- Most cardholders save 25%–40% on brand-name prescription drugs and products. The Together Rx Access Card is accepted at the majority of pharmacies nationwide and in Puerto Rico.
- More than 300 FDA-approved prescription products from 10 major companies are offered in the program, including medicines to treat high cholesterol, diabetes, asthma, and many other conditions. - To qualify for the Together Rx Access Card, applicants must:
 - Not be eligible for Medicare
 - Have no prescription drug coverage (public or private)
 - Have household income equal to or less than
 - \$30,000 for a single person
 - \$40,000 for a family of two
 - \$50,000 for a family of three
 - \$60,000 for a family of four
 - \$70,000 for a family of five
 - Be a legal resident of the US or Puerto RicoFamilies of six or more and residents of Alaska and Hawaii should contact Together Rx Access at 1-800-444-4106 for household income information.
- In addition to participating in the Together Rx Access Program, each of the 10 companies independently offers Patient Assistance Programs (PAPs). - The Together Rx Access Card builds on the success of the Together Rx[®] Card. In that historic initiative, seven of the Together Rx Access companies — Abbott Laboratories, AstraZeneca, Aventis Pharmaceuticals, Bristol-Myers Squibb Company, GlaxoSmithKline, Johnson & Johnson**, and Novartis Pharmaceuticals Corporation — offered savings, right at the pharmacy counter, to eligible seniors. Seniors using the Together Rx Card received savings of over \$1 billion. Now that the Medicare prescription drug benefit has been enacted into law and voluntary prescription drug coverage went into effect in January, Together Rx's mission is complete.

*Each cardholder's savings depend on such factors as the particular drug purchased, amount purchased, and the pharmacy where purchased. Participating companies independently set the level of savings offered and the products included in the program. Those decisions are subject to change.
